




New Beginnings with Stitch Colour Cloth

PERTH ACADEMY REMEMBERS- Friday 16th September at 7pm

79 former pupils of Perth Academy lost their lives in the Second World War and thanks to a generous grant from Culture Perth & Kinross, Living Communities Participation Fund and the Gannochy Trust, the school are honouring their sacrifice by producing a film.

The film will include contributions from the students themselves, friends of the school and interviews with descendants of the fallen.

Many of these former Perth Academy pupils also appear on the St Matthew's War Memorials and we have therefore agreed to provide a venue for the "World Premiere" of this film which will take place as above.
